# Temporary registration - export of new vehicle

Transportstyrelsen (The Swedish Transport Agency) can approve a temporary registration of a new vehicle that is to be exported from Sweden and therefore not be registered for permanent use here. A temporary registration can be valid for 3, 6 or 12 months and can be approved when the applicant, i.e. the buyer of the vehicle, is not a permanent resident of Sweden. The applicant could also be a Swedish resident who intends to move from Sweden within 3 months.

## How to apply

The application must be completed by the buyer. The following documents shall be attached to the application:

- Insurance certificate for temporary registration issued in the country to which the export refers, when exporting to
  another EEA country and the export is completed within 30 days from purchase in Sweden. If more than 30 days
  have passed since purchase, or when exporting to a country outside of the EEA, use a Swedish insurance for
  temporary registration instead. (This does not apply to trailers.)
- Certificate of conformity (CoC) in the original for a vehicle that is EU type approved, or a Swedish manufacturer's certificate or other document showing that the vehicle passed a registration inspection less than twelve months before application, unless equivalent information appears in the vehicle registry.
- The Swedish registration certificate in original version with a notification of deregistration (export), signed by the seller of the vehicle and the Swedish number plates.(This does not apply to unregistered vehicles.)

The last point is the responsibility of the seller in Sweden.

If the period of validity is not specified in the application, temporary registration is automatically processed for 12 months. Send your application to Transportstyrelsen, 701 81 Örebro.

### When the application has been approved

When temporary registration has been approved, the following documents are sent to the applicant's address in Sweden:

- Special number plates with a new registration number in white on a red background. Mount the plates on the vehicle immediately.
- A registration certificate and the approved temporary registration. Keep these documents with you during travel and present to a police officer or vehicle inspector upon request.

If a 30-day insurance certificate is being used for the application, the vehicle will be uninsured as of day 31 and for the remaining period of validity, unless the insurance is renewed through a Swedish insurance company.

If the vehicle changes owner, the temporary registration expires immediately.

The period of validity cannot be extended. We cannot approve a new temporary registration for the vehicle before 12 months have passed since the end of a previous temporary registration period. Destroy the special number plates when the temporary registration expires.

### Use in Sweden and abroad

A vehicle with temporary registration may be used in normal traffic in Sweden, but not for commercial purposes.

Rules for use of temporarily registered vehicles may differ from country to country. It is therefore advisable to check the rules in the intended country of use.

If you are currently a Swedish resident intending to move abroad, the vehicle must be exported during the first 3 months of its temporary registration. Otherwise, you must contact the Swedish Customs and the Swedish Tax Agency.
