## RESOURCE MANAGEMENT

### (d) Report on arrears of contributions and of advances to the Working Capital Fund and on the implementation of Article 56 of the IMO Convention

#### Note by the Secretary-General

#### SUMMARY

**Executive summary:** This document informs the Council of the status of Member States' contributions and of advances to the Working Capital Fund as at 28 February 2003 and the position on the implementation of Article 56 of the IMO Convention.

## 1 Introduction

1.1 This report informs the Council of the status of contributions and of advances to the Working Capital Fund at 28 February 2003 and the current situation with regard to the implementation of Article 56 of the IMO Convention.

## 2 Application of Article 56 of the IMO Convention – 22nd regular session of the Assembly

2.1 The Council will recall that at its twenty-second regular session, the Assembly considered the applications for waiver of the provision of Article 56 of the IMO Convention, concerning the right to vote, in accordance with Rule 56bis of its Rules of Procedure and granted waivers to four Member States on reviewing the schedule of payments submitted and pledges made by these Member States to settle their arrears. 26 Members were not granted a waiver and consequently lost their voting rights.

2.2 Of the four Member States which were granted waivers, Guatemala cleared its arrears in accordance with its undertaking and paid its contribution for 2002. The remaining three Members are listed in Annex I to this document. Benin and Costa Rica have not yet cleared their arrears in accordance with their undertakings. The Government of Serbia and Montenegro<sup>1</sup> has stated that, concerning the arrears of £355,306, the settlement depends on the results of on-going negotiations regarding succession issues, which should be finalized in the near future. Consequently, the Government of Serbia and Montenegro will discharge its share of financial obligations due to IMO only upon the conclusion of the negotiations on succession.

2.3 Of the 26 Members which lost their voting rights at the twenty-second regular session of the Assembly in November 2001, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Cameroon, Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Pakistan and Senegal have paid their arrears in full including the 2002 contributions and regained their right to vote. The remaining 20 Members are listed in Annex I and the payments received during this year are shown therein.

2.4 Details of the current situation in respect of those Member States which fell within the scope of Article 56 of the IMO Convention as at 28 February 2003 are shown in annex 1 to this document.

### 3 The current position

3.1 The situation regarding contributions due and payable by all Member States as at 28 February 2003 is summarized below:

3.2 The total amount due to the Organization as at 28 February 2003 amounted to £15,952,560. Details with respect to individual Member States may be found at annex 2 to this document. A separate schedule showing the status of Council Members is attached at annex 3.

### 4 2003 assessments

4.1 The notice of assessments for 2003 and the corresponding individual invoices showing the assessments due were issued in December 2002. The assessment notice drew the attention of Member States to the relevant Financial Regulations concerning payment of contributions, to Assembly resolution A.904(22) which urged Member States to pay their contributions in accordance with the Organization's Financial Regulations and to the Rules of Procedure of the Assembly concerning the non-payment of contributions. The Director of Administration also wrote to Ambassadors, High Commissioners and Permanent Representatives in London seeking their assistance in expediting the payment of assessments due. It will be recalled that it is incumbent upon all Member States to pay their contributions within 30 days of receipt of the notice of assessment or on the first day of the calendar year to which they relate, whichever is later. Therefore, all contributions should be considered due by the end of January 2003.

4.2 However, as shown in paragraph 3.1 above, total contributions received for 2003 as at 28 February 2003 amounted to £5,436,960 which represented only 28% of the annual assessment. The comparable figure in 2002 was 33.5%. The Council will wish to have in mind that, as the Organization's accumulated reserves are applied to the Headquarters Capital Fund and other Funds of the Organization, it becomes increasingly important that Member States pay their contributions on time in accordance with the Organization's Financial Regulations. Continued slippage in timely payment opens up the future possibility of liquidity difficulties.

4.3 Of the 162 Member States and 2 Associate Members included in the notice of assessments, 43 have made full payment of their 2003 assessment, 16 have made partial payment and 105 have made no payment as at 28 February 2003.

4.4 As shown in Annex 3 to this document, of the 40 Council Members, 15 have made full payment of their 2003 assessments, 5 have made partial payment, and 20 have made no payment. The total amount outstanding for 2003 from Council Members as at 28 February 2003 amounted to £10,666,040 which is equivalent to 54.9% of the total 2003 assessment and 76.2% of the balance due from all Members for 2003 as at 28 February 2003.

## **5 Arrears**

5.1 The total arrears for 2002 and earlier years as at 1 January 2003 amounted to £1,859,794. The total received during the period January to February 2003 in settlement of arrears amounted to £196,671 which represented 10.6% of the arrears outstanding as at 1 January 2003. Annex 4 shows the details with respect to those Member States with arrears at 28 February 2003.

## **6 Working Capital Fund**

6.1 Assembly resolution A.838(19) established the Working Capital Fund at a level of £2 million by the transfer of £375,000 each year in 1996 and 1997 from the surplus of the Printing Fund. Taking into account these transfers and advances to the Fund from Members which have joined the Organization since 1 January 1988 amounting to £5,859, the Fund balance currently stands at £2,005,859 of which £75 remains unpaid at 28 February 2003.

## **7 Action requested of the Council**

7.1 The Council is invited to take note of the information contained in this document and any addendum thereto and to comment or decide as appropriate.
