RELATIONS WITH NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS

(b) Review of organizations in consultative status

Note by the Secretary-General

SUMMARY

<i>Executive summary:</i>	Periodic review of the list of non-governmental organizations in consultative status with IMO

1 Rule 10 of the Rules Governing Relationship with Non-Governmental International Organizations requires the Council to review from time to time the list of non-governmental organizations to which consultative status has been granted, in order to determine whether the continuance of that status in any particular case is necessary and desirable, and to report to the Assembly accordingly. In pursuance of this rule, the Council usually undertakes biennial reviews.

2 The previous review by the Council was completed at its twenty-first extraordinary session in November 2001. In accordance with past practice, a review is due this year. The present document provides the Council with the background information for the review as follows:

- Annex 1 gives the current list of non-governmental organizations enjoying consultative status with IMO; and
- Annex 2 contains information on:
- (a) the participation of the non-governmental organizations in the work of IMO from 1 March 2001 to 28 February 2003: and
 - (b) the meetings of non-governmental organizations in consultative status which have been attended by representatives of the IMO Secretariat from 1 March 2001 to 28 February 2003.

For reasons of economy, this document is printed in a limited number. Delegates are kindly asked to bring their copies to meetings and not to request additional copies.

“Provisional basis” of the consultative status of some organizations

3 Two organizations enjoy consultative status with IMO on a provisional basis. These organizations and the reasons for the decisions of the Council on their status are set out below:

Association of European Shipbuilders and Shiprepairers (AWES) 1979

- 3.1 In recognizing the regional character of the Association, the Council at its ninth extraordinary session in November 1977 decided to grant consultative status to AWES on a provisional basis until such time as a “more international” body might emerge to replace the Association on a permanent basis. Since then, no such application from a “more international body” has been received and AWES continues to enjoy its consultative status with IMO. At its review in June 1999, the Council requested the Secretary-General to approach the Secretary of AWES and ask that it represent its case with a view to being granted consultative status on a permanent basis. The information provided by AWES was submitted to the Council at its twentieth extraordinary session in November 1999.
- 3.2 In its consideration, the Council noted the regional character of the Association and considered that it would not be possible to change the provisional status of AWES without a change to the Guidelines, which did not permit IMO to grant consultative status to organizations that were not truly international. It was recalled that, to facilitate the participation of such organizations, the term “provisional” had been introduced. Unless the Guidelines were changed, the term “provisional” would remain unchanged. The Council, therefore, decided to retain the provisional status granted to AWES.
- 3.3 At its eighty-sixth session in June 2001, the Council amended Rules 1 and 5 of the Rules Governing Relationship with Non-Governmental International Organizations and the introduction to the Guidelines to provide for the grant of consultative status on a provisional basis for a period not exceeding four years. At the same session, the Council reviewed the provisional status of AWES and decided to maintain it without change.

International Ship Suppliers Association (ISSA) 1989

- 3.4 At its sixtieth session in June 1988, the Council considered the views of the Legal Committee that ISSA could make a contribution to its work, particularly in the specific field of maritime liens and mortgages and arrest of ships. It suggested that ISSA be granted consultative status for the purpose of assisting the Organization while these matters were still on its work programme.
- 3.5 The Council decided to grant consultative status on a provisional basis to ISSA as recommended by the Legal Committee, subject to further review by the Council in accordance with the procedures of the Organization. The activities of the Legal Committee in the area of maritime liens and mortgages and arrest of ships are now completed. ISSA participated in the IMO/UNCTAD Conference on Arrest of Ships in March 1999.

- 3.6 At its eighty-sixth session in June 2001, the Council reviewed the provisional status of ISSA. The Council noted the statement made by the representative of ISSA and decided to maintain its provisional status for the time being and to request the Legal Committee to examine the future contribution of ISSA and to report back to the Council.
- 3.7 The Legal Committee, at its 83rd session in October 2001, re-examined this issue and in the light of its subsequent recommendation, the Council, at its twenty-first extraordinary session in November 2001, reiterated its decision to maintain the provisional status of ISSA and encouraged it to participate in the work of the Legal Committee, as well as the other Committees in which it has an interest.

**Outstanding Matter arising from the eighty-ninth session of the Council:
Greenpeace International**

- 4 At its eighty-ninth session in November 2002, the Council:
- (i) noted the receipt of communications from Turkey and Greece regarding the boarding and occupation by Greenpeace International activists of the Greek Oil Tanker **Crude Dio** outside the Turkish territorial sea off the northern entrance to the Strait of Istanbul on 4 July 2002;
 - (ii) noted the views of Greenpeace International on this matter, as well as on the incident involving BNFL ships in the Tasman Sea;
 - (iii) noted the views expressed by Members of the Council, reiterating the necessity for Greenpeace International to comply with the international regulations concerning the safety of navigation and, in particular, collisions at sea and requested the Secretariat to monitor the activities of Greenpeace; and
 - (iv) decided to review this matter at the next periodic review of non-governmental organizations to be held at its ninetieth session in June 2003.

The Council may, therefore, wish to review the matter of Greenpeace International.

5 In accordance with Rule 10 referred to above, the conclusions of the Council, together with any recommendations, will be submitted to the Assembly for consideration and necessary action at its twenty-third regular session.

Action requested of the Council

6 The Council is invited to consider the information provided in this document and to decide as appropriate.
