Security at IMO Headquarters

With reference to circular letter No. 2429 of 15 November 2002 concerning security at IMO Headquarters, all delegates will be required on first arrival to show proof of their identity, e.g. passport. Additionally, Member States are required to submit the list of their representatives to meetings prior to the meeting date, to be entered into the list of participants database. The registration form attached hereto should be used for every delegate attending, including Permanent Representatives to IMO. Delegates whose names appear in the list of a particular meeting will be issued with the requisite pass which will include a photograph of the bearer. Delegates whose names are not on the list will be requested to provide evidence of their authorization to attend the meeting. Early arrival on the starting day of a meeting would be of assistance and registration will begin from 7.30 a.m.
