1 The twenty-sixth regular session of the Assembly is due to be held at the Headquarters of the Organization from 23 November to 4 December 2009.

2 The plenary meetings will be held in the Main Hall on the ground floor. Committee 1 (Administrative, Financial, Legal and Technical Co-operation Committee) of the Assembly will also be held in the Main Hall when there is no plenary meeting. Committee 2 (Technical Committee) will be held in Meeting Room 9 on the second floor. During plenary sessions, a video link will be established between the Main Hall and Committee Room 9 to permit participants in excess of the capacity of the Main Hall to observe the proceedings.

3 Arrangements for the holding of the twenty-sixth session of the Assembly are progressing according to plan. A general information leaflet providing practical guidance to Member States and other representatives invited to the meeting will be issued in due course in all the official languages of the Organization.

4 Administrative arrangements in connection with the preparation and counting of the ballot for the election of Council members, including the use of electronic equipment, are in hand.
