1 The twenty-eighth extraordinary session of the Council considered document C/ES.28/9/1, submitted by Jamaica, Liberia, the Marshall Islands, Panama, the United Kingdom, BIMCO, IACS, ICS, INTERCARGO and INTERTANKO, on the principles to be considered in the review of existing requirements and the development of new requirements.
