Background

1 At its 118th session in July 2017, the Secretary-General reported on the Day of the Seafarer 2017 and shared early figures, as the Council took place in close proximity with the campaign. The Secretary-General indicated he would update the Council at its next session with the final figures.

Action taken to mark the Day of the Seafarer

2 Council document C 118/17(h) reported on the success of the Day of the Seafarer campaign. Updated figures show that Twitter reached 13 million people, while Facebook reached more than 10 million. Additionally, an estimated 3.5 million people were reached via online articles. The annex to this document features a comprehensive list of all the participants who registered on our newly added virtual map, as well as other stakeholders who helped promote the campaign. These results have been reported to the Assembly in document A 30/18(h), which will not be reissued.
