

INTERNET ACCESS

IMO Wi-Fi access has been upgraded to provide users a more secure and also broader coverage throughout the building (Wi-Fi networks: IMOGUEST and IMOPUBLIC).

DEDICATED NETWORK FOR DELEGATES

Delegates are advised to log-on to “**IMOGUEST**” Wi-Fi using their IMO web-account’s credentials. When prompted for

CABLE CONNECTION

Ethernet cables are available underneath your desk for wired connection to the network. Additional cables may be requested, on loan, from the Conference Desk on the second floor, with a step-by-step user guide to connect to the network
