Introduction

1 This document provides an explanation of the process to align the outputs to the new Strategic Directions and, in annex 1, the draft list of outputs for the 2018-2019 biennium with the alignment to the new Strategic Directions. Additional explanation about the new Strategic Plan can be found in document C 118/3.

Aligned outputs

2 In accordance with the instructions by the Council, the Secretariat has realigned the outputs to the new Strategic Framework. The relevant outputs have been considered and approved by FAL 41, LEG 104, MSC 98 and MEPC 71. TC 67 will also consider those outputs relevant to its work and the Council will be informed accordingly.

3 While FAL 41, LEG 104, MSC 98 and TC 67 will be reporting to C 118 in the usual way, MEPC 71, however, will be reporting to C/ES.29 due to the proximity of the meeting to C 118. However, in order for the Council to be able to review all the components of the new Strategic Plan during its 118th session, the Secretariat compiled the newly aligned outputs with FAL, LEG, MSC and MEPC as the parent organ, which have already been approved by the respective Committees. For those outputs with the Assembly, Council and TCC as the

parent organ, the preliminary alignment proposed by the Secretariat have also been included to provide the Council with a complete list of outputs for the 2018-2019 biennium. The final alignment of outputs by TC 67 will be attached to the report of TC 67 to C 118.

Numbering System

4 In addition to the alignment of outputs to the new Strategic Directions, another consequential change became necessary because of the simplification of the new Strategic Plan, i.e. the direct alignment of the outputs to the Strategic Directions and the omission of the High-level Actions. The simplification of the Strategic Plan allowed for the reduction of the output number from four to two digits, with the first digit indicating the alignment to the Strategic Direction. The outputs aligned to "Other Work" are accompanied by the abbreviation "OW".

5 The complete list of outputs for the 2018-2019 biennium can be found in annex 1 to this document. For the Councils information, the alignment of outputs to the new Strategic Directions currently on the post-biennial agenda has also been added in annex 2.

Action requested of the Council

6 The Council is requested to approve:

- .1 the outputs for the 2018-2019 biennium aligned to the new Strategic Directions for which the Assembly or the Council is the parent organ;
- .2 the consequential numbering system for the outputs; and
- .3 the list of outputs for the 2018-2019 biennium to be included in the Strategic Plan of the Organization for the six-year period 2018-2023.
