SUMMARY

Executive summary: This document reports on follow-up actions taken by MSC 83 regarding the applications for consultative status by the International Paint and Printing Ink Association (IPPIC); the International Fund for Animal Welfare (IFAW); and the Global Maritime Education and Training Association (GlobalMET)

1 Further to the information provided in document C/ES.24/12(b) regarding the applications for consultative status by the International Paint and Printing Ink Association (IPPIC); the International Fund for Animal Welfare (IFAW); and the Global Maritime Education and Training Association (GlobalMET), the Council is advised that MSC 83 decided to recommend that consultative status be granted to all three organizations since they were found to meet the requisite criteria, in particular because they were assessed to be able to contribute directly to the Committee's work and did not seem to have access to IMO through other organizations.
