DATE AND PLACE OF THE NEXT SESSION OF THE COUNCIL

Note by the Secretary-General

SUMMARY

Executive summary: This document makes proposals concerning the dates and places of the two forthcoming sessions of the Council, both of which are scheduled to take place during the refurbishment period

Action to be taken: Paragraph 4

Related documents: None

1 The ninety-seventh and ninety-eighth sessions of the Council are scheduled to take place in the autumn of 2006 and the spring of 2007 respectively. Both meetings will, therefore, be held during the refurbishment period and appropriate arrangements are being made for them to be held in London in alternative locations outside Headquarters.

2 In accordance with the relevant decision of the Council at its twenty-third extraordinary session, it is proposed that the ninety-seventh session of the Council take place from Monday, 6 to Friday, 10 November 2006, at the **Central Hall Westminster**, London, United Kingdom.

3 Taking into account the provisional programme of meetings of the Organization for 2007 and the availability of suitable conference facilities, it is further proposed that the ninety-eighth session of the Council take place from Monday, 25 to Friday, 29 June 2007 in London, the precise venue to be advised at a later stage.
