PLACE, DATE AND DURATION OF THE NEXT TWO SESSIONS OF THE COUNCIL

1 As per the established practice and in accordance with its previous decision, the twenty-seventh extraordinary session of the Council will meet at the Headquarters of the Organization, on **Thursday, 21 and Friday, 22 November 2013**, immediately prior to the twenty-eighth session of the Assembly, which is scheduled to take place from Monday, 25 November to Wednesday, 4 December 2013. The twenty-seventh extraordinary session of the Council is convened to deal with any matter that may need to be considered before submission to the Assembly.

2 The 111th regular session of the Council is scheduled to be held also at the IMO Headquarters at the conclusion of A 28 on **Thursday, 5 December 2013**. At that session, the Council will elect its officers, as provided by rule 19 of its Rules of Procedure and conduct any other business that may be necessary.

3 Regarding the number of plenary sessions requiring interpretation at these two meetings, it is recommended that, in accordance with IMO working practices and the AIIC Agreement, budgetary provisions are made for four sessions in a two-day contract and two sessions in a one-day contract with full interpretation for each meeting respectively.

4 The Council is invited to note the proposed venue and confirm the proposed dates, as well as to decide on the number of plenary sessions requiring interpretation at the forthcoming two sessions of the Council.
