## Instructions for Completing the Form

### Information about the Area

- 1 The upper and lower limits of the area must be stated in feet (ft) with a height reference, or in flight level. Height reference can be AMSL (Above Mean Sea Level) or AGL (Above Ground Level).
- 2 If the lower limit coincides with the ground, GND (Ground) must be stated as the reference. If the lower limit coincides with the sea surface, SFC (Surface) must be stated.

### Examples of correct notation of upper and lower limits:

- GND-4000 ft AMSL (the area extends from ground level up to 4000 feet above mean sea level).
  - SFC-FL70 AMSL (the area extends from sea level up to flight level 70).
  - 3000 ft AMSL-FL195 (the area extends from 3000 feet above mean sea level up to flight level 195).
- 3 Coordinates must be stated in WGS84 in the format DDMMSS with up to maximum three decimals. Coordinates should be ordered clockwise, starting with the northwesternmost coordinate
  - 4 If the area is defined as a circle, the radius must be stated in nautical miles.

### Time of Establishment

- 5 Times of establishment must be given as follows:
  - YYYY-MM-DD, HH:MM (e.g., 2025-04-01, 12:00).
- 6 Schedules must be given as follows:
  - DAY HH:MM-HH:MM (eg., MoN 07:00-16:00).
  - If a whole day is applicable, H24 may be stated, or alternatively 00:00–23:59.

### Times when the area will be used for activity

- 7 If the activity will take place within specific time intervals (e.g., daytime or Monday–Friday), this must be stated. The same format for dates, days, and times as in the examples above must be used.
  - Example: MON–FRI 08:00–15:00 means the area is used every day Monday to Friday between the specified times.
