Information and instructions

Subcontracting/outsourcing

When staff are hired from outside the organisation, the hired organisation is indicated as a subcontractor.

Swedish citizenship

Those holding Swedish citizenship are required to present a valid passport, ID card or other ID document issued by the Swedish authority verifying their identity. Copies of these identification documents shall not be enclosed with the application.

Foreign citizenship

Foreign nationals are required to present a valid national passport or a national ID card (EU-citizen) verifying the identity. When applying for a criminal records check, certified copies of the original valid passport or national ID card shall be attached to the application. The copies are required to be in colour and to include the following relevant pages: photograph, social security number, full name, signature, country of birth, gender, validity period and MRZ-code. A copy of the passport's hardcover is also required.

In order to authenticate the copies, the reference person, the manager or a designated employee shall attest the passport copies. The attestation shall be written on the actual copies, taking care to not block out any printed information. The attestation shall contain the following information:

- a. Please write "I hereby attest that this is a true copy of the original"
- b. Signature
- c. Your name in block letters
- d. Position
- e. Telephone number

Restrictions

Please note, the Swedish Migration Agency has restrictions on passports and ID documents from certain countries that are not accepted as proof of identity. The Swedish Transport Agency complies with these restrictions, which means that these ID documents will not be accepted for verifying identity when applying for criminal records checks.

Country of residence other than Sweden during the last five years

When a company employs a person who has had a country of residence* other than Sweden during the past five years, the person is required to present extracts from criminal records from the authorities in the respective country/countries of residence showing that no crimes have been committed. The extract must be in English or Swedish or translated into one of these languages, by an authorised translator. The extract in the original language and the translation, shall be attached to the application in order to perform a criminal records check.

*Country of residence refers to any country in which a person has been resident continuously for six months or more; an interruption means unreported time for more than 28 days in the employment or training list.

Declarations by the reference person

In the application for a criminal records check the reference person must be able to declare with certainty:

- That a basic background check, approved by the employer, has been carried out.
- That consent to a criminal records check has been obtained from the applicant, documented in a specific form which has then been saved in the applicant's personal file for potential presentation during an inspection by the competent authority.
- That consent to a criminal records check has been obtained from a guardian, if the applicant is under 18 years of age, documented by a specific form which has then been saved in the applicant's personal file for potential presentation during an inspection by the competent authority.

It is therefore important that the reference person is aware that the above-mentioned tasks have been carried out by a designated person, if it is not their responsibility to carry them out themselves.

Basic background check

A basic background check refers to an investigation of personal relationships that are of importance for security clearance. The investigation shall include a security clearance interview, gathering and assessment of qualification, certificates, references and other relevant information. The documents obtained must describe employment and education for the past 5 years including any gaps of more than 28 days.

The company shall ensure that the security clearance is performed for the intended person through a reliable identity check. A correctly completed application for a criminal records check with the necessary attachments, shall be sent to the Swedish Transport Agency when the following have been completed. Firstly, the person for whom the criminal records check concerns shall undergo an approved basic background check. This includes a security clearance interview. Secondly, the person has been deemed trustworthy by the company with the interests protected in the Protective Security Act (2018:585). Thirdly, the person is deemed as loyal from a security point of view in accordance with Chapter 3 Section 2 of the Protective Security Act.

Access to an airport with security restrictions

In the event that the person for whom the criminal records check concerns needs access and a badge to a security-restricted area at an airport, the application must be sent to the airport concerned to be signed by a security officer. The airport will then forward the application to the Swedish Transport Agency.
