

Safety




Hazard:

is a **condition** <u>or</u> an **object** with the potential to **cause** <u>or</u> **contribute** to an *aircraft incident* <u>or</u> *accident*.




Safety risk:

refers to the predicted *probability* and *severity* of the *consequences* or *outcomes* of a hazard.



Risk ≈ *Unsafety of Safety*
