STA Information Update – December 2020

Delegation agreement with instructions

Our current delegation agreement entered into force on the 1st of November 2019. The main changes were as follows:

- RO is allowed to issue electronic certificates
- STA tacit approval of the Ballast Water Management Plan is replaced with an STA explicit approval

Additions to the degree of authorisation:

- International Code for Ships Operating in Polar Waters
- EU regulation on Ship Recycling, No 1257/2013

The STA issued instructions to the RSOs regarding ISPS survey and certification, applicable from the 1st of November 2020.

Inventory Certificate (EU Ship Recycling Regulation)

All Swedish vessels applying the regulation shall have an Inventory Certificate on board at the latest on the 31st of December 2020. However, the EU Commission has issued Commission Notice Guidelines regarding the enforcement of obligations under the EU Ship Recycling Regulation, indicating that vessels may be late fulfilling the obligations due to the covid-19 pandemic and proposing that EU port state authorities should apply a harmonized approach when inspecting these vessels for a limited period of 6 months (until the 30th of June 2021).

If Swedish vessels are late fulfilling the requirements according to the regulation the ship owner/company shall contact the ship relevant inspectorate office¹, to apply for a deferral of meeting the requirements. Note that this will only be permitted if the company have taken all possible measures to certify the vessel.

If asbestos has been identified during the Inventory of Hazardous Materials on board vessels built after the 1st July 2002, the *Swedish requirements and instructions for the handling of identified asbestos on board ships built after the 1st July 2002* shall be applied (see attached document). Workshops during 2021

The ambition of the STA is to invite the ROs to (digital) workshops in areas where there can be a need for discussions or clarifications. We will start this trial with a workshop on the 4th of February 2021, where we like to discuss a recommendation given to the STA by the Swedish Accident Investigation Authority, due to a seriously injured crewmember on board a Swedish vessel. The underlying factor to the accident was, according to the report by the SAIA, that the safety management system was not fully implemented on board the vessel. Invitation to this workshop is sent separately.

Please let us know if you have any matters you wish to discuss or any need for clarification in areas related to the delegated tasks, so that we may take this into consideration when preparing for further workshops.
