

Regulations for winter tyres in Sweden during the winter period, December 1st-Mars 31th if there is snow, ice, melting snow or frost on any parts of the road surface.

POR= Professional Off Road

M+S also include the markings M.S, M&S, M-S och Mud and Snow.

Tyres with some of these markings or are studded fulfils the definition of winter tyre within each dates.
